



## Andrea Morris

December 10, 1949 - March 29, 2026

Andrea “Andi” Susan Morris, 76, of Chicago’s Edgewater neighborhood, longtime American Airlines flight attendant. The day before she passed away unexpectedly but peacefully in her sleep, Andi was standing outside with her walker, in front of her senior building (the Breakers), protesting for No Kings Day.

Andi was born in Brookline, MA the eldest child of Max, an independent sales representative in the apparel industry and Helen, a bookkeeper also in the fashion industry. After graduating from Solomon Lewenberg School in Mattapan, MA. Andi took college classes and embarked upon one false start in the airline industry at the age of 21, followed by a brief career in retail fashion sales. She returned to the airline industry in 1976 at the age of 24 and never looked back. Andi was a kind mentor to younger flight attendants and of course, traveled the world. After fifty years with American Airlines, Andi retired in 2024.

Andi was an avid reader, independent, and enjoyed attending the theater, concerts, and sports.

Andrea is survived by her younger brother Jeffrey (Brandi) Evans of Beverly Hills, CA, and his stepchildren from his first marriage: Bobby (Tara) Sandler of Atlanta and Michael Sandler of Bonita Springs, FL.

Preceded in death by sister in-law Ruth Sandler and parents Max G. Morris and Helen Roslyn Morris (nee Gilman).

She also leaves behind many, many friends and colleagues from her American Airlines family.

The family has chosen a simple, direct cremation. Andi's cremated remains will be scattered on Lake Michigan and also a small amount will go to London, England, one of her favorite places.
