Christian “Chris” Barrymore Collins, 22, of Fort Myers, Florida, passed away on November 11, 2025.

Born on May 20, 2003 in Chicago, Illinois, Chris grew into a young man whose quiet strength and deep faith guided him throughout his life. He loved the Lord wholeheartedly. Though often a man of few words, when he spoke, his insight, humor, and quick wit left a lasting impression on all who listened.
