A celebration of Cris' life is being planned. Pleaes check back to this website for information.

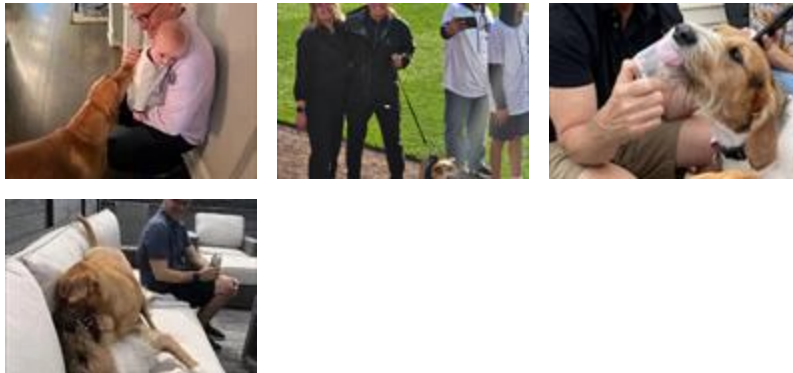
