Edward Joseph Przybylski, 75, of Beloit, Wisconsin, passed away on September 30, 2025.

Born and raised on Chicago's South Side, Edward attended Lindblom Math and Science Academy and received his bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from DeVry University. A gifted and self-taught handyman, Ed started learning and working hands-on with mentors at Pluskota Electrical at age of fourteen. His successful career as an electrical supervisor included stints at Nabisco, Campbell's Soup, Sweetheart Cup, and finally retiring from Hormel Foods.
