January 25, 1939 - November 20, 2022

Elvira DeBorde, 83, of Villa Park, passed away peacefully surrounded by her adoring family on Sunday, November 20.

She was born to her cherished mother, Maria Petra Del Angel in Tampico, Mexico on January 25, 1939.
