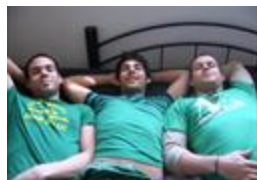
There were a lot of ups and downs, and many good talks throughout the short time we knew each other. He really was a sweat kid at heart.
