



## Evelyn A. Talangbayan

February 21, 1938 - July 28, 2023

Evelyn Agtuca Talangbayan, 85, retired neonatal intensive care nurse, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by family in Chicago's Streeterville neighborhood on July 28, 2023.
