Marc Dino Teichert, “Cubby”, 44, of Chicago’s Rogers Park, passed away after recently being diagnosed with esophageal cancer.

Born in Germany. Marc attended earned his degree in I.T. management and support. For several years he worked for Siemens, where he was responsible for the IT service for their main customer, the German Military, maintaining highly secured communication server systems for the European NATO. For the last six years, Marc did tech support at Pharmacare Hawaii.

On September 4, 2018, in a fit of insomnia, he met online the man with whom he would fall in love. Marc was in Hawaii and Hendric was in Los Angeles, so the hours worked out for these late-night conversations. At the end of their conversations, the couple would listen to their special song, “Goodnight Sweetheart, Goodnight” by the Spaniels. Marc was a very uneasy flier and one sympathetic flight crew gifted him “Ted”, a comfort bear. Ted made many, many trips with Marc. After two years of nervous flights and wonderful visits, the couple decided to be together for real. Hendric left LA to enjoy the pandemic with his new love.

Marc loved film scores (not soundtracks). He was a gifted composer and musician. He is survived by his partner of eight years, Hendric Figueroa and his stepbrother Thomas Flerus and cousin Lisa Dellweg, both of Germany. Son of the late Lutz Teichert and Inge Taufenback Teichert.

Marc Dino Teichert, genannt „Cubby“, 44 Jahre alt und wohnhaft in Rogers Park, Chicago, verstarb, nachdem bei ihm erst vor Kurzem Speiseröhrenkrebs diagnostiziert worden war.

Marc wurde in Deutschland geboren und erwarb einen Abschluss in IT-Management und -Support. Mehrere Jahre lang arbeitete er für Siemens, wo er für den IT-Service des Hauptkunden – der Bundeswehr – verantwortlich war und hochsichere Kommunikationssysteme für die europäischen NATO-Streitkräfte wartete. In den letzten sechs Jahren war Marc im technischen Support bei Pharmacare Hawaii tätig.

Am 4. September 2018 lernte er – während einer schlaflosen Nacht – online den Mann kennen, in den er sich verlieben sollte. Marc befand sich zu jener Zeit auf Hawaii und Hendric in Los Angeles; die Zeitverschiebung kam ihren nächtlichen Gesprächen daher sehr entgegen. Zum Abschluss ihrer Unterhaltungen hörte das Paar stets sein ganz besonderes Lied: „Goodnight Sweetheart, Goodnight“ von den Spaniels. Marc war ein sehr ängstlicher Flieger; eine besonders einfühlsame Flugbesatzung schenkte ihm einst „Ted“, einen kleinen Trostbären. Ted begleitete Marc auf sehr, sehr vielen Reisen. Nach zwei Jahren voller nervenaufreibender Flüge und wunderbarer Besuche beschloss das Paar, fortan gemeinsam durchs Leben zu gehen. Hendric verließ daraufhin Los Angeles, um die Zeit der Pandemie an der Seite seiner neuen Liebe zu verbringen.

Marc liebte Filmmusiken (im Sinne von *Scores* – nicht bloße *Soundtracks*). Er war ein begabter Komponist und Musiker. 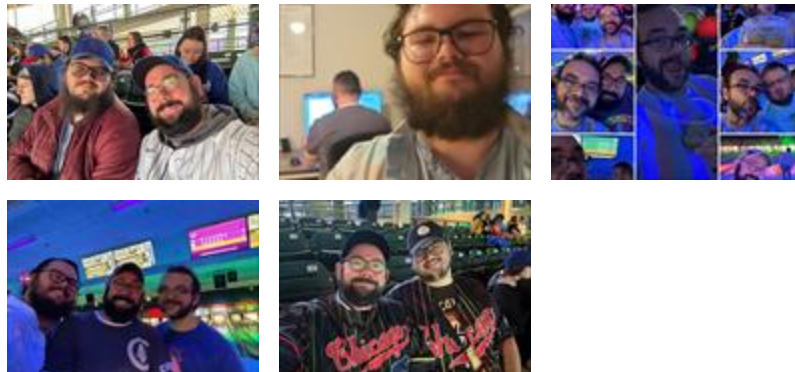
