Miguel Angel Torres, 62, aka Miki “Mixin” Torres, “Lette”, “Pollito”, or “Meche Leche”, of Chicago’s Dunning neighborhood passed away July 12, 2025.

Born in Chicago to Puerto Rican parents, he was the fourth child of nine. He grew up in the West Town neighborhood where he attended William H. Wells Community Academy High School. In his youth he enjoyed baseball, breakdancing, and swimming at Eckhart Park.

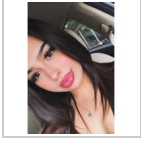

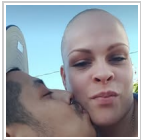
