Mitchell Clair Miller 65, of Chicago's Uptown neighborhood, passed away after a valiant battle with Pulmonary Fibrosis, which came about after he contracted COVID in March 2020 and Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) in 2021.

Mitch's final wish was to travel to North Carolina to be near his sister. He died absolutely on his own terms, shortly after landing at the Raleigh/Durham airport.

Born in Elgin, Illinois, Mitch graduated from Dundee Community High School and apprenticed as a Swiss Screw machinist before studying massage therapy at DuPage College, specializing in deep tissue and cranial sacral therapy. He later worked as a loan officer.

Mitch was a thoughtful person and a spiritual seeker. He enjoyed making art with paints and clay, was also an avid downhill skier, loved live music, frequented coffeehouses, and traveled to Europe, Hawaii, and the Caribbean Islands.
