September 1, 1977 - February 6, 2023

Nathan Edward Stowell, 45; born in Albuquerque, NM, raised in Chicago's Bucktown neighborhood and in Hinsdale, IL; passed away unexpectedly February 6, 2023, at home in Chicago's Lincoln Park neighborhood.

After graduating from Hinsdale South High School, Nathan worked as a bike messenger in Chicago. An athletic outdoorsman, Nathan literally blazed new hiking trails and maintained others in Montana's wilderness areas, hiking in with pack mules and shovels, He was youngest person to win Chicago's 1999 bike messenger race. Nathan studied environmental science and photography at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette.

In 2002, a devastating car accident and spinal cord injury changed the course of Nathan's life. Although he endured multiple surgeries and procedures over the last two decades, Nathan managed to attend many festivals and concerts and lived independently at Anixter Center apartments. He loved photographing the beauty of the Lincoln Park Conservatory, music, science fiction, and snorkeling when he visited his family's home in Mexico.
